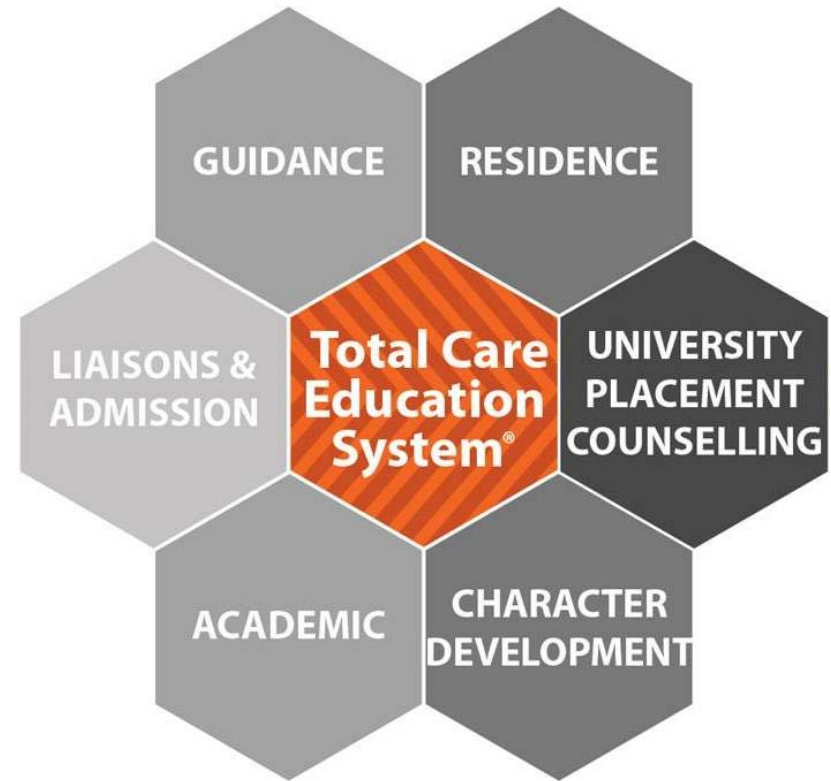

- Create **Personalized Success Plan (PSP)**
 - Academic Support
 - Social Support
 - Emotional Support
 - Physical & Health needs



SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL SKILLS

Is it possible to attain true academic and personal success without addressing SEL skills?

Job Creation

- Every 3 international students create 1 job (DFAIT)
 - Education Industry
 - Hospitality industry
 - Transportation/Taxi Industry
 - Tourism Industry
 - Restaurants
- On an annual basis, Columbia employs over 300 people. An additional 100 staff members are brought in by food service provider Sodexo.

Local Business

- Introduce students to local community and encourage them to give back
 - 2014: Students collectively spent **49,256.50 hours** volunteering:
